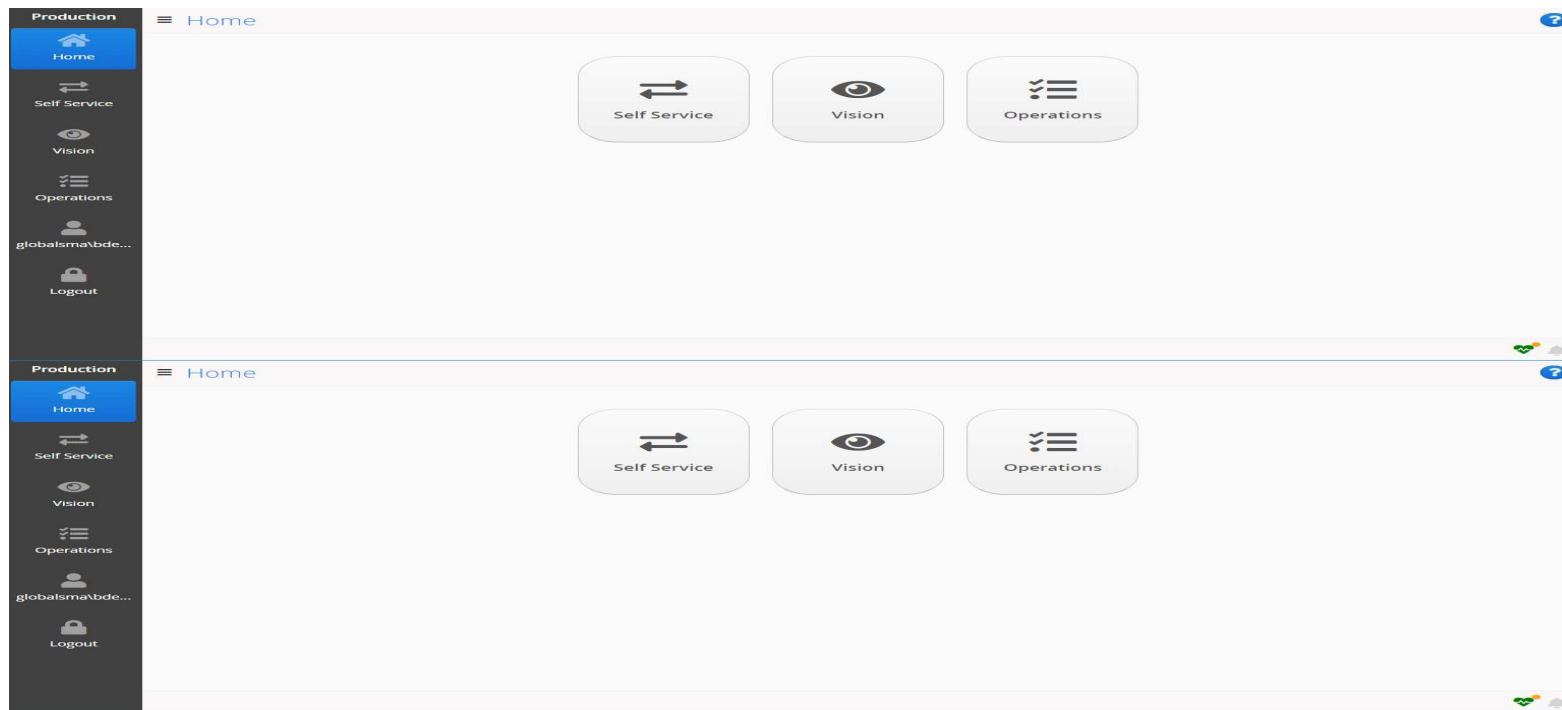

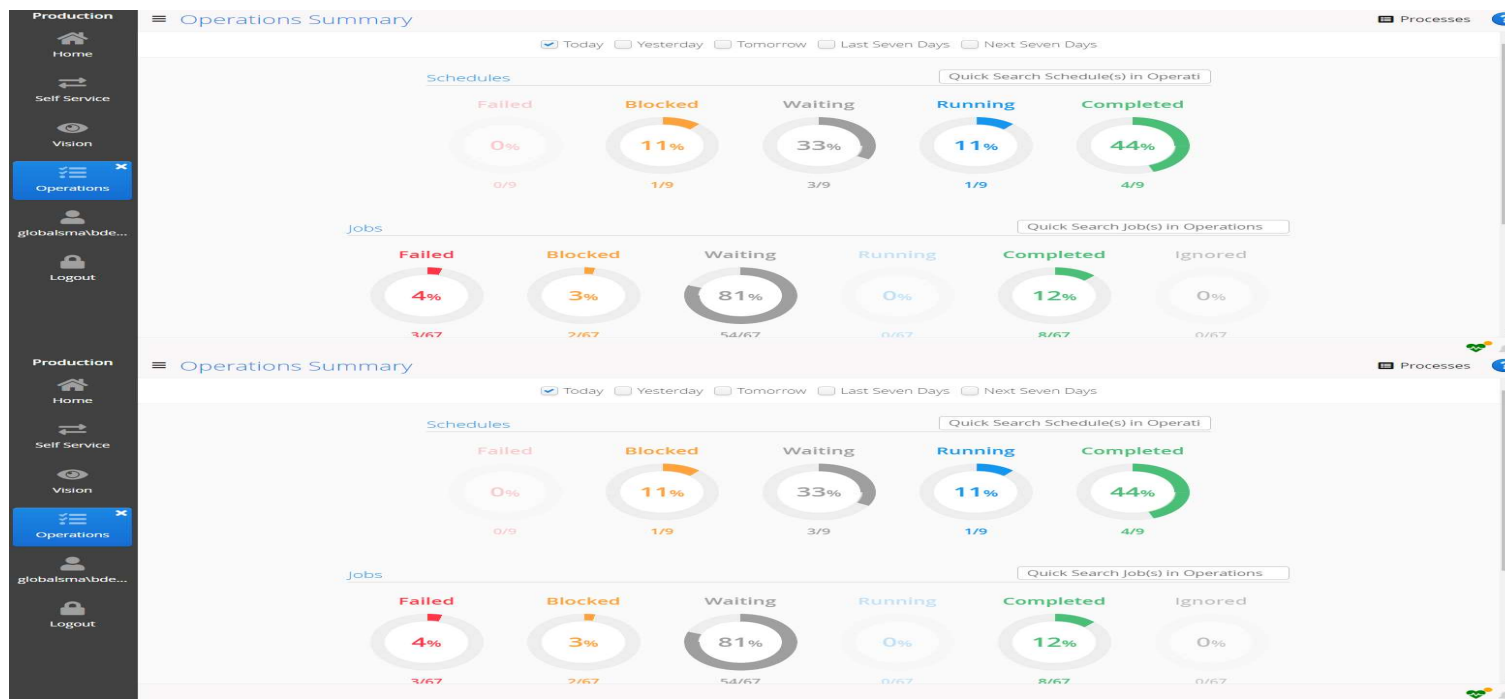

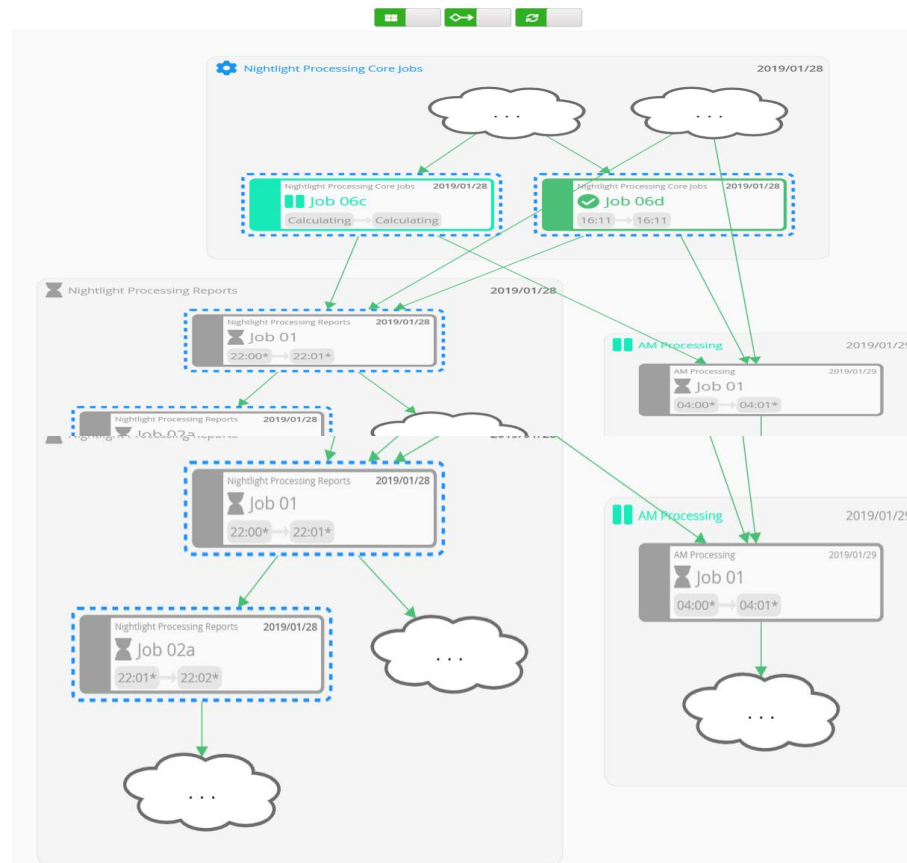

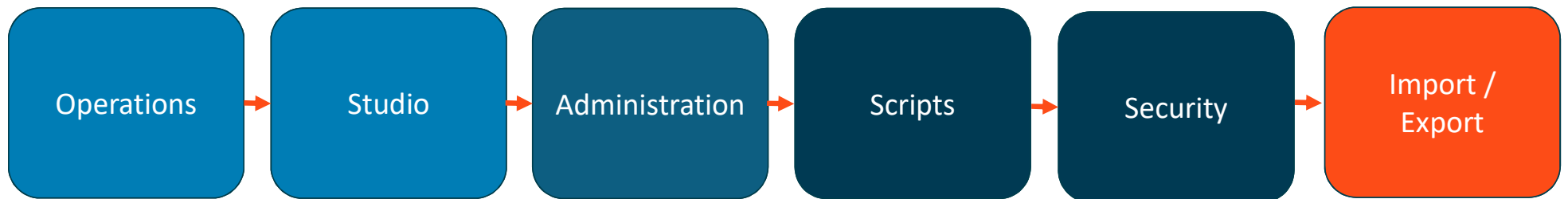

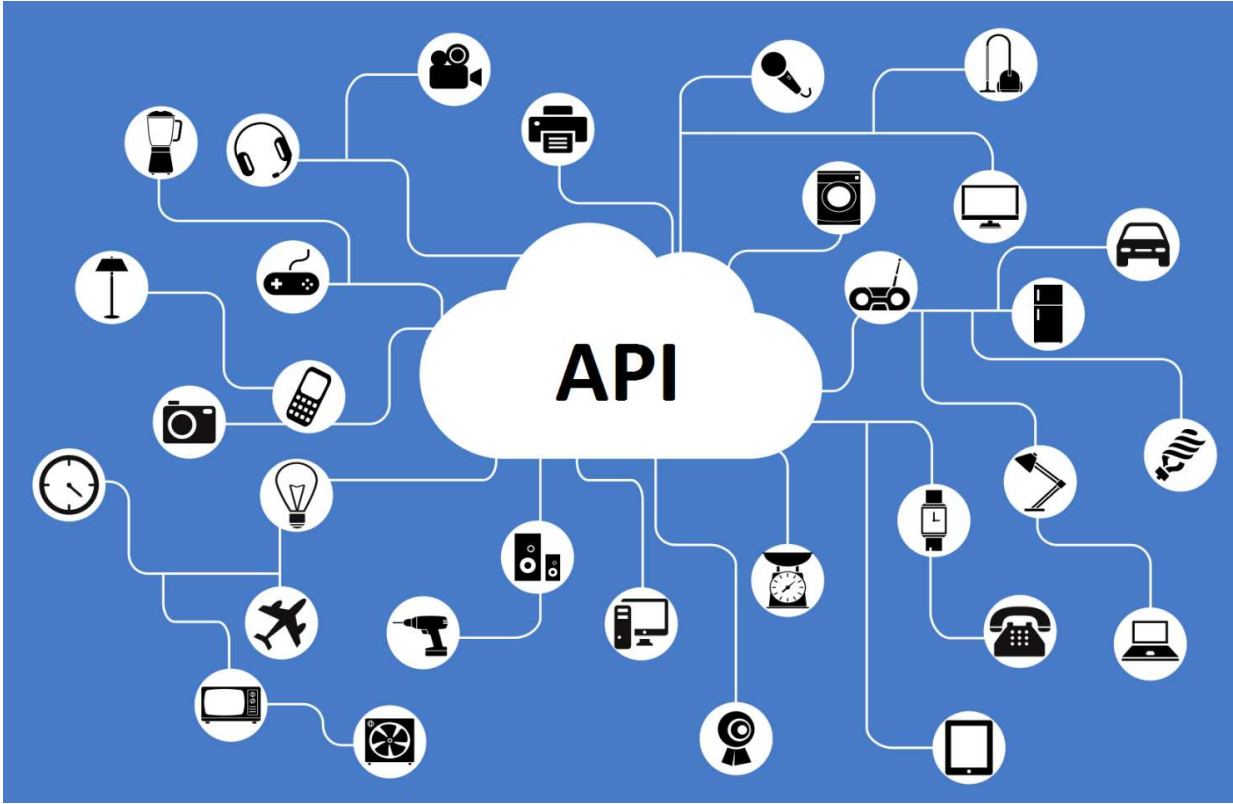


Increase Simplicity – Solution Manager Timeline

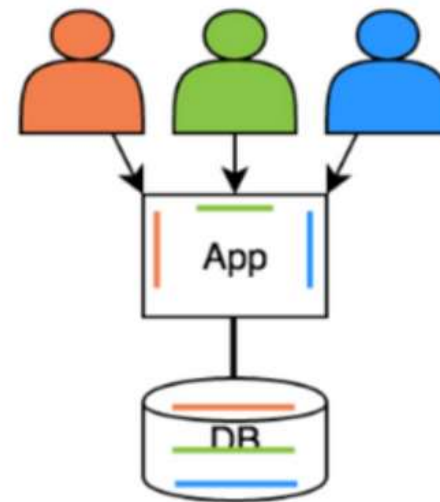
